2. Pop open and fold down the Turtle shell back. This becomes the top of the mixing tank. Swing up the cab front as shown.

1. Position Construction Mutation Michaelangelo's feet so they are turned out, as shown. Rotate his head so he's facing straight back.

head is facing forward. Unfold the cab windshield assembly by lifting and pulling up. Position the cab up and over Michaelangelo's head, swing the doors up, then down and snap into place. Then fold down the cab rear window and snap into the two side panels

3. Pull straight up on the cab front to expose the front wheel assemblies. Fold out the side arm panels around as far they will go, so Michaelangelo's arms are tucked together.

4. Unsnap the front wheels and swing them out as far as they will go. Pull out on the front wheel support flap as shown. Swing Michaelangelo's legs up, one foot under the other.





5. Swing both front wheels into position and snap the front wheel support flap down to lock into place, as shown. Separate and fan open both back wheel assemblies. Rotate both assemblies around and snap them into place by locking tabs into slots, as shown.
